

Climate Research in the LSO

Abstract:

The Southampton Oceanography Centre (SOC) Laboratory for Satellite Oceanography (LSO), established in 2001, brings together a wide range of expertise. It consists of 20 full-time staff and more than 10 research students and visiting scientists. The role of the Laboratory is two-fold: to facilitate leading edge research into techniques and applications of ocean remote sensing; and also to promote the use of satellite ocean data wherever possible, not only at Southampton Oceanography Centre, but in the wider oceanographic research community. In this presentation an overview of some of the current climate research, carried out within the LSO, will be given.
